Purpose

Membership is open to area high school juniors and seniors who demonstrate an interest in and commitment to helping the families who come to Mobile seeking medical care for their ill or injured child. Young adults selected for membership on this leadership board will develop self-confidence and leadership skills while engaging in age-appropriate activities designed to meet the unique needs of our community. The KREWE members gain life-enhancing skills while experiencing the fulfillment that comes from the sharing of one’s time and talents with others.

Selection Process

Applicants must submit a signed application **and photo of self**. All paperwork **MUST** be signed by a parent or guardian. Most KREWE members are active two years. A selection Committee that includes Ronald McDonald House staff and one or more members of the RMH Board of Directors will review the applications and determine the finalists. Finalists will then sit for an interview with members of the committee.

RMH Red Shoe Krewe Requirements and Responsibilities

1. Attend regularly scheduled meetings (online or in person)* beginning in August and ending in May. **Only two unexcused absences are permitted.** If a KREWE member knows in advance that he/she will miss a meeting, they must e-mail, call or text the House and/or team leader to ensure their absence is marked “excused.”
2. Attend project team meetings on an as-needed basis.
3. Volunteer a minimum of 30 hours per academic year.
4. Represent Ronald McDonald House of Mobile as an “official ambassador” at various community service events and fundraisers.
5. Raise visibility and awareness of RMH of Mobile at his/her school.
6. Participate in all designated projects individually and with your team.
7. Communicate with Red Shoe Krewe team and RMH advisors through e-mail/text/GroupMe
8. Raise a minimum of \$250 using resources and guidance from the RMH staff.
